

“Food, Glorious Food!”
Victoria Quilters Guild
Small Works Show for our 2021 Calendar

Part 1

- Create a small quilt 20” x 16” – landscape orientation – based on your interpretation of the theme **“Food, Glorious Food!”**.

Your quilt may be constructed in any style, with any construction method, and using any combination of colours – but there must be some reference to **FOOD**. Use your **IMAGINATION** and **HAVE FUN!** Your quilt should be appropriate for one of the four seasons – i.e. Winter; Spring; Summer; Fall. Try to think “Season” as opposed to “Holiday” themes.

- Each quilt must have a hanging sleeve on the back that is a minimum of 2” wide.
- Each quilt must have an affixed label on the back, clearly featuring Name of Quilt, Season represented; Quilter’s Name, contact phone number and email address. No quilter identification on the front please!

Each quilter may enter a maximum of 4 quilts – **one only for each Season**. At the Voting Finale, the quilts will be displayed anonymously and grouped according to Seasons of the year. Voters may choose ONE for each of the 4 Seasons. The top 3 for each Season will be awarded a calendar month. The two highest-voted 4th place (all categories combined) will be awarded Front & Back covers.

Part 2

With each quilt entered, you **must** also **submit a favourite recipe** appropriate for the Season of your quilt and in some way linked to your image (e.g., a fruit pie recipe would be appropriate for a quilt depicting a fruit tree). Bear in mind that quilters are busy people and they want to make the biggest impression with the least amount of fuss – so please keep it (relatively) simple – the recipes printed in the calendar will be limited to 4” x 5” index card size. When submitting your favourite seasonal recipe, you must name your source – be it self-created; your Auntie Alice Andrews; Good Housekeeping, etc., etc. For all of the 12 winning quilts, each quilter will also have her/his recipe included. The recipes will be placed at the front and rear of the calendar in card-sized sections so they can be cut out and saved.

Entry Forms are attached to these rules (if viewing online, please print Entry Forms separately). Enclose entry form, quilt and recipe together in a NON-SEE-THROUGH BAG. Each entry must be submitted in a separate bag (maximum of 4 per quilter).
