2. It may be original or made from a pattern (please credit the designer if it is from a pattern). It must be free of any text or images that are protected by copyright.
3. It may include embellishments, such as beads, embroidery, ribbons, paint, etc.
4. The edges must be finished with binding, have closed edges, or stitching.

Suggested quilted items: a small quilt, a quilted tote bag, a garment, a cushion, a stuffed animal, etc

There will be prizes, selected by viewers choice ballots.

We want to encourage participation and all entries will be displayed.
