

VICTORIA QUILTER'S GUILD – QUILT SHOW SALE POLICIES 2026

Customers return to our sale year after year. They are looking for quality, up-to-date, handmade, fabric items that are unique, well-made and priced.

Where else can one buy hand-made quilts and items that showcase our Guild members' talents? We encourage all our guild members to participate.

We especially like to see fresh ideas from the quilting world - items that are pieced, appliquéd, layered, with hand or machine stitching, or with some thread painting or embellishment etc.

Rules for Submitting items for the sale:

Items must be of fabric, quilt related and must be of good quality and workmanship

- Use the minimum pricing list and the 6-cent calculation. (see page 2)
- Quilts and other items priced \$75 and over must use blue price tags and be listed on the blue inventory sheet. Sizes must be included on the blue sheet.
- Quilted items priced under \$75 must use white price tags and be listed on a white inventory sheet.
- Baby quilts: For safety reasons, no invisible thread may be used on baby quilts.
- Wall hangings will vary in price, based on size and the amount of work involved.
- Pre-printed panels are acceptable when used in baby quilts, wall hangings, place-mats or quilts but should include quilting and/or piecing.
- All items must be fragrance free - no potpourri, lavender, etc, or items that smell of smoke.
- Permission must be obtained from the copyright holder before reproducing designs from copyrighted patterns. Pattern author should be noted on label.

Please check in with Store coordinators (Guylaine Forman or Jacquelyn Jacobi) 15 minutes before your shift start time.

Pricing must be provided on VQG tags. No business cards or phone numbers on tags or inside items.

Please provide a self-addressed stamped envelope for your payment cheque.

Prices must be in dollar increments and cannot be changed during the sale.

Vendors are responsible for PST (if registered) on their own sales. The VQG does not collect or remit sales taxes on behalf of its members.

It is the responsibility of the vendor to insure sale items for loss or damage. VQG does not provide insurance against theft or damage.

Unsold items must not be placed in the sale for more than **two** consecutive sales.

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The sale is not juried; however, the receiving committee reserves the right to remove or refuse any item which is inappropriate as to technique, quality, workmanship, or price. If you are unsure about the suitability of an item you propose to sell, please phone one of the coordinators in advance of the sale.

Pricing - These are minimum prices, please feel free to price items higher:

Placemats - \$40 and up for a set of 4

Table Runners - \$40 and up

Designer Bags - \$30 and up

Wine or Gift bags - \$5 and up

Cosmetics/Zippered bags - \$12 and up

Tea cozies - \$25 and up

Aprons - \$30 and up

Potholders set of 2 - \$15 and up

Coasters set of 4 - \$12 and up

NO CHRISTMAS ITEMS

All items priced \$75 and above must have blue tags and be itemized on **Blue Inventory Sheet**. All quilts, including baby quilts, must follow the 6 cent rule.

Size of Quilt to be written on ALL tags.

Quilt Pricing Math

Measure the width and the length. Multiply the two numbers for a square inch size amount.

Multiply this number by 6 cents to arrive at a fair price.

This sounds like a skill testing question for a prize, but it works! Test it out on table runners, small and large quilts, wall hangings, etc.
