The next Victoria Quilters' Guild **mini project**

Mission statement:

A project for all guild members to participate in.

All entries will be displayed.

Encourage fresh ideas along with favourite techniques. A chance for members to try something new that they have been thinking about. It is small, so not a huge commitment.

Shop local brick and mortar shops, thrift stores/upcycling, and use the stash, the good stuff.

No rules except for size, 3 layers and faced edges.

Potential for display opportunities, next quilt show, for calendar and note card production with potential guild revenue.

Instructions/Rules:

1. *It must consist of the usual 3 layers.*
2. *Size - 20" by 16", landscape orientation*
3. *The edges finished with a facing (not a binding)*
4. *Must have a 3" sleeve, sewn across the top for hanging*
5. *Have a label with your name and phone number stitched on the back.*
6. *Hand it in before, or by Stitch Day, April 2027*

Selection of quilts for calendar use will be voted on at a Stitch Day by the membership.

Suggestions for inspiration

Any type of bird or flock of birds, from anywhere in the world.

Fantasy bird shapes, bird houses, feathers, etc.

Winged Insects, etc, etc.

- Demos on several techniques will happen at Thursday Stitch Days.

Techniques may involve any of the following:

Traditional, Contemporary, Art

Machine and/or hand stitching

Curved piecing

Paper piecing

Appliqué - traditional or raw edge

Landscape, Abstract, etc.

Embellishments
